

GCSE results day 2026 advice:



What to do if:

- **You have the results for the courses you applied for at King Edward VII Sixth Form** – Well done! Make sure you attend the enrolment this morning – Thursday 20th August. For the exact time refer to your enrolment letter. If you do not enrol today or let us know (e-mail p16admissions@kes.sheffield.sch.uk) we will assume you are not joining the Sixth Form and your place may be allocated to one of the students on our waiting list.
- **You have the results for the courses you applied for but wish to change some** – Well done! Make sure you attend the enrolment this morning – Thursday 20th August and explain what you wish to study. For the exact time refer to your enrolment letter. If you do not enrol today or let us know (e-mail p16admissions@kes.sheffield.sch.uk) we will assume you are not joining the Sixth Form and your place may be allocated to one of the students on our waiting list.
- **You don't have the results for the courses you applied for, but you do for other courses** – Make sure you attend the enrolment this morning – Thursday 20th August so we can make those decisions about your place in Sixth Form. For the exact time refer to your enrolment letter. If you do not enrol today or let us know (e-mail p16admissions@kes.sheffield.sch.uk) we will assume you are not joining the Sixth Form and your place may be allocated to one of the students on our waiting list.
- **You do not have an offer for King Edward VII but now have the grades and wish to study here** – Please make sure you attend the enrolment this morning – Thursday 20th August. We will consider your request alongside requests from students who are already on our waiting list.
- **You do not meet the entry requirements for King Edward VII** – We will be unable to offer you a place. We only recruit to courses in Y12 where students have met the entry requirements. We are oversubscribed with students who have met the entry requirements so this means that any student starting a course will need to have the academic foundations to make a success of their Sixth Form Study.
- **Y12 enrolment for KES Sixth Form** – for KES students is taking place on the morning of Thursday 20th of August. We will also be enrolling external students on Friday 21st of August with a late enrolment on the afternoon of Tuesday 1st September.



What to do if:

- **You have the results for your college course** – Well done! If you have applied, been interviewed and been given a conditional offer, you should have got an induction date and time. You need to attend college on that date and time and bring your results with you and college will start the full induction process.
- **You don't have the results for your college course** – If you have applied, been interviewed and been given a conditional offer, you should have got an induction date and time. Regardless of your results, you should still attend college on that date and time, with your results, and staff in college can have a chat with the course tutors about looking at an alternative course or alternative level. Do not worry, college will help you as best they can.
- **If you haven't got a place at college but now think that's your best option** – If you have not made an application, you need to make an application online <https://sheffcol.ac.uk/how-to-apply>, and you will be invited in for open enrolment in September for a course interview. College cannot guarantee open enrolment will happen for all course areas, as this will only happen if spaces are available. Do not worry, college will help you as best they can.

Make sure you attend your induction time and date given, if you are away during the time and date you have been given, let college know and they can look at giving you a date and time that is more suitable. Also, regardless of what happens results wise, the college will never shut the door on you, there will be a course that is right for you, based on your actual results.



What to do if:

- **You have the results for your college course** – Well done! Bring your results along with you to enrolment. You will receive a letter with information at the beginning of August.
- **You don't have the results for your college course** - Get in touch with Longley Park as soon as possible - either via Sheffield Progress, call on 0114 262 5757, or you can pop in and see staff, who will do their best to offer you an alternative course, depending on your results.
- **If haven't got a place but now think that's your best option** - There will still be an opportunity for you to apply to Longley Park Sixth Form as they do still take late applications. You need to get in touch as soon as possible to arrange an appointment. Call 0114 2626 5757.
