- A brief intro, context and history – up to date and relevant – no waffle; clear & concise
- Exemplar work and its impact – analysis and explanation
- Why you have chosen them – reasoned justification

You may *choose* to present the work in the style of your chosen designer / group.

Outcomes / deliverables:

Your outcome for supporting the presentation can be:

- A prezi presentation of not more than 10 transitions
- A PowerPoint presentation of not more than 10 slides.
- An A2 Image board / interactive display.

It must not be a Wikipedia list on slides!

Deadline:

The outcome must be available for assessment from the first taught lesson after the induction sessions.

You will be expected to complete a presentation to the group during the first 2 weeks of lessons.
